MOTHER'S DAY

Mother's Day is a holiday honoring motherhood that is observed in different forms throughout the world. The American incarnation of Mother's Day was created by Anna Jarvis in 1908 and became an official U.S. holiday in 1914. Following her mother's 1905 death, Anna Jarvis conceived of Mother's Day as a way of honoring the sacrifices mothers made for their children.

In looking at Moses' Mother, we can see 3 great examples to follow:

“¹ Now a man from the house of Levi went and took as his wife a Levite woman.” Exodus 2:1 (ESV)

“² The woman conceived and bore a son, and when she saw that he was a fine child, she hid him three months.” Exodus 2:2 (ESV)

_____ THROUGH WITH IT.**

“⁵ Now the daughter of Pharaoh came down to bathe at the river, while her young women walked beside the river. She saw the basket among the reeds and sent her servant woman, and she took it.

⁶ When she opened it, she saw the child, and behold, the baby was crying. She took pity on him and said, “This is one of the Hebrews’ children.” Exodus 2:5-6 (ESV)

⁷ Then his sister said to Pharaoh’s daughter, “Shall I go and call you a nurse from the Hebrew women to nurse the child for you?”

Exodus 2:7 (ESV)

3. DO WHAT YOU CAN TO INSTILL A SENSE OF _____.

⁸ And Pharaoh’s daughter said to her, “Go.” So the girl went and called the child’s mother. ⁹ And Pharaoh’s daughter said to her, “Take this child away and nurse him for me, and I will give you your wages.” So the woman took the child and nursed him. Exodus 2:8-9 (ESV)
