


Takeaway Thoughts:

The **Lord's Supper** is a visible representation symbolizing the death of Christ for our sins. It reminds us of Christ's death and the glorious hope of his return. Our participation in it strengthens our faith through fellowship with Christ and with other believers.

The **bread** represents the incarnate body of Christ unselfishly assumed and unselfishly given on the cross for the benefit of others, that we need to be constantly remembering.

The **cup** represents the New Covenant between God and people, sealed by the shedding of Jesus' blood. This New Covenant is that Jesus died in the place of sinners (you and me). Jesus' blood truly removes the sins of all who put their faith in Him.
