1. GOD'S _____ CAN PIERCE THE DARKEST DARKNESS.

¹¹ If I say, “Surely the darkness shall cover me, and the light about me be night,” ¹² even the darkness is not dark to you; the night is bright as the day, for darkness is as light with you.

Psalm 139:11-12 (ESV)

*O Light that followest all my way,
I yield my flickering torch to thee;
My heart restores its borrowed ray,

2. GOD'S _____ IS ALWAYS WITHIN THE SOUND OF YOUR VOICE.

“⁷ Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence? ⁸ If I ascend to heaven, you are there! If I make my bed in Sheol, you are there!” Psalm 139:7-8 (ESV)
