## 1. CONTEXT AND CAPERNAUM.

<sup>1</sup> After he had finished all his sayings in the hearing of the people, he entered Capernaum. <sup>2</sup> Now a centurion had a servant who was sick and at the point of death, who was highly valued by him.”

Luke 7:1-2 (ESV)

## 2. THE CENTURION'S \_\_\_\_\_

<sup>3</sup> When the centurion heard about Jesus, he sent to him elders of the Jews, asking him to come and heal his servant. <sup>4</sup> And when they came to Jesus, they pleaded with him earnestly, saying, “He is worthy to have you do this for him, <sup>5</sup> for he loves our nation, and he is the one who built us our synagogue.” Luke 7:3-5 (ESV)

## 3. THE CENTURION HAD \_\_\_\_\_

<sup>6</sup> And Jesus went with them. When he was not far from the house, the centurion sent friends, saying to him, “Lord, do not trouble yourself, for I am not worthy to have you come under my roof.

<sup>7</sup> Therefore I did not presume to come to you...” Luke 7:6-7a (ESV)

## 4. THE CENTURION UNDERSTOOD \_\_\_\_\_

<sup>7</sup> ... But say the word, and let my servant be healed. <sup>8</sup> For I too am a man set under authority, with soldiers under me: and I say to one, ‘Go,’ and he goes; and to another, ‘Come,’ and he comes; and to my servant, ‘Do this,’ and he does it.” Luke 7:7b-8 (ESV)

## 5. THE CENTURION'S \_\_\_\_\_

<sup>9</sup> When Jesus heard these things, he marveled at him, and turning to the crowd that followed him, said, “I tell you, not even in Israel have I found such faith.” <sup>10</sup> And when those who had been sent returned to the house, they found the servant well. Luke 7:9-10 (ESV)
