2<sup>nd</sup> Timothy 2:15 (ESV) <sup>15</sup> Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth.”

1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 8:1-3 (ESV) <sup>1</sup> Now concerning food offered to idols: we know that “all of us possess knowledge.” This “knowledge” puffs up, but love builds up. <sup>2</sup> If anyone imagines that he knows something, he does not yet know as he ought to know. <sup>3</sup> But if anyone loves God, he is known by God.

1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 13:2-3 (ESV) <sup>2</sup> And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. <sup>3</sup> If I give away all I have, and if I deliver up my body to be burned, but have not love, I gain nothing.

**2. RADICAL SPIRITUALITY IS EVIDENCED BY \_\_\_\_\_.**

1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 8:9-11 (ESV) <sup>9</sup> But take care that this right of yours does not somehow become a stumbling block to the weak. <sup>10</sup> For if anyone sees you who have knowledge eating in an idol’s temple, will he not be encouraged, if his conscience is weak, to eat food offered to idols? <sup>11</sup> And so by your knowledge this weak person is destroyed, the brother for whom Christ died.”

**3. RADICAL SPIRITUALITY IS EVIDENCED BY \_\_\_\_\_.**

1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 8:13 (ESV) <sup>13</sup> Therefore, if food makes my brother stumble, I will never eat meat, lest I make my brother stumble.”

Romans 14:21 (ESV) <sup>21</sup> It is good not to eat meat or drink wine or do anything that causes your brother to stumble.”
